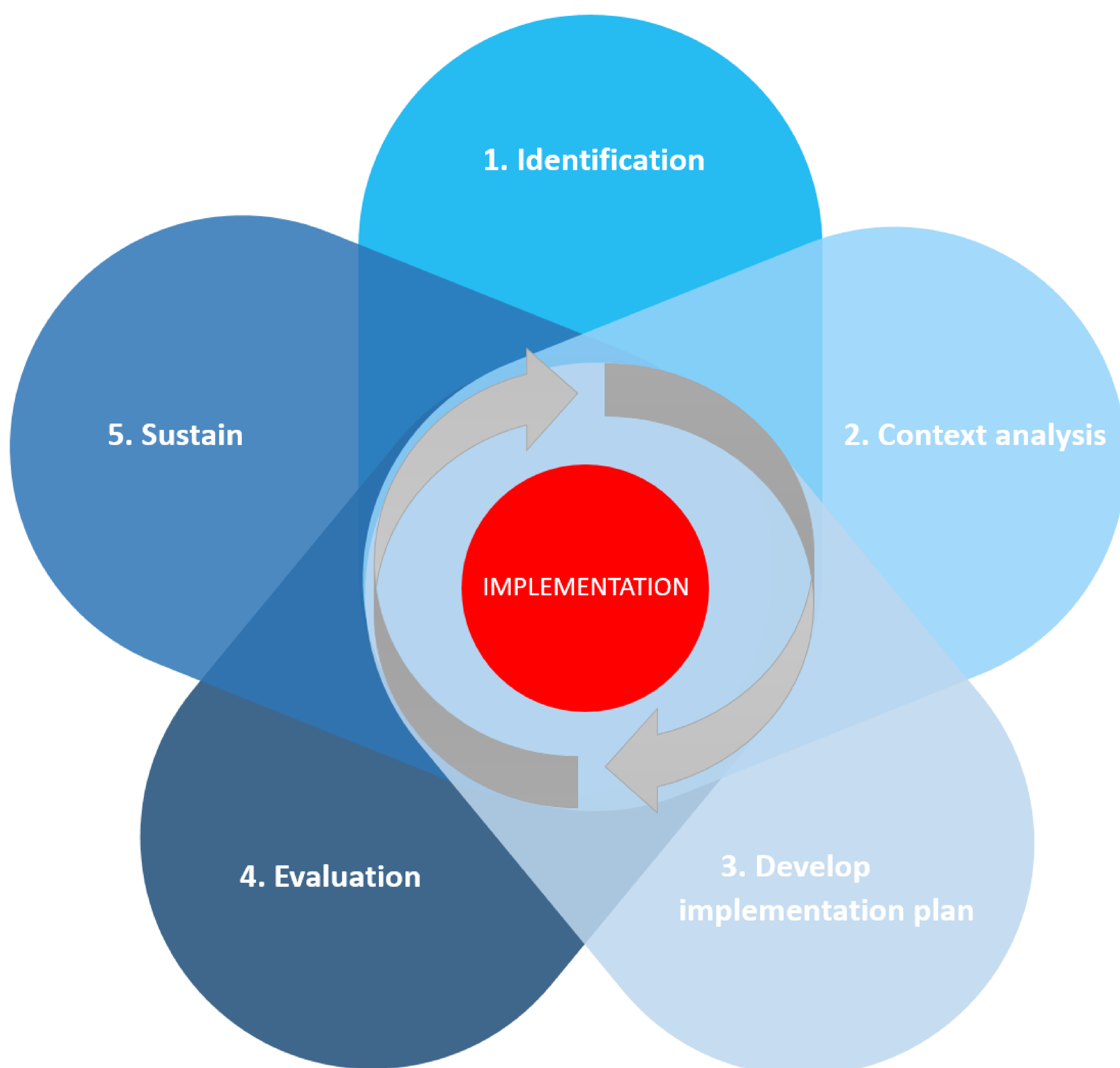


Adjusted Knowledge to Action Framework



1. Identification

- ✓ Guideline implementability appraisal
- ✓ Know-do gap analysis
- ✓ Determine what needs to change

2. Context analysis

- ✓ Identify barriers & facilitators
- ✓ Prioritise
- ✓ Assess readiness

3. Develop implementation plan

- ✓ Link interventions to barriers
- ✓ Tailor & implement interventions
- ✓ Develop action plan
- ✓ Identify quality indicators for evaluation

4. Evaluation

- ✓ Assess quality indicators
- ✓ Monitor & provide feedback

5. Sustain

- ✓ Integrate new practice in routine care
- ✓ Adjust action plan
- ✓ Embed new practice in organisation
